Smt R.M.Prajapati Arts college organized by Babulal Punamchand Vidhyasankul has become center of excellence in education for boys and girls students of Gadhavada area. The college commenced in 1965 with only 65 students is having now total strength of 2056students. four languages Gujarati, English, Hindi, and Sanskrit and social studies are offered as a principal subject and three languages except English are offered as subsidiary subjects as well as five subjects are offered for post-graduation fin the college.

The college got B grade(2.79 point)in second cycle by National Assessment and Accreditation council along with this the college is honoured with the award of 'Potential for Excellence'by UGC. The college has got 13<sup>th</sup> rank in all streams and first rank in arts stream in HNGU in the list of best colleges of India -2016 by national magazine 'Careers 360'.

Semester wise strength is also noteworthy in college. In this year,771 students in first semester, 522in third semester and 502in the fifth semester, total 1795students are studying in third year B.A. 261 students are studying in post-graduation department. The college has external examination center.

last year semester wise result of the college was also noteworthy.
