The college got B grade(2.79 point)in second cycle by National Assessment and Accreditation council along with this the college is honoured with the award of 'potential for excellence'by UGC. The college has got 13th rank in all streams and first rank in arts stream in HNGU in the list of best colleges of India -2016 by national magazine 'Careers 360'.
