A BRIEF ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK

The analysis report on the feedback of the alumni related to the syllabus of academic year 2016-2017 is presented here briefly.

* Alumni feedback on Syllabus:

The questionnaire used for collecting data from the alumni regarding the syllabus consists mainly eight points which are prepared with the objective to know the opinion of the students in relation with several topics attached to the present syllabus. The topics are about the content of the syllabus, ability of the syllabus to develop the skills useful in real life, objectives of the syllabus, availability of the syllabus related books in the library along with overall rating of the syllabus.

The analysis of the data collected through questionnaire provides following information.

- 8% alumni believe that the syllabus is excellent and there is no need to make any change in it.
- 61% alumni believe that the syllabus can be considered good but not excellent. It means, they wish to bring some changes in it particularly in the area of utility of syllabus in real life.

27 % alumni put it in the category of satisfied. It means, for them, it is average kind of syllabus having need of improvement.

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- 4% alumni are totally dissatisfied with the syllabus and wish to change entire syllabus. For them, in all the aspect, it is useless syllabus.

In short, alumni of all the subjects are satisfied with some aspects of the syllabus but express their dissatisfaction regarding utility of it in real life.
